**Objective** : To Provide Latin American model Motorola hand held radios and accessories to the Federal Agency in Port-au-Prince Haiti.

**Needs Assessment** : IPA worked with the agency to provide Latin American Motorola equipment, that is compatible with their existing network and local requirements in Haiti.

**Equipment & Supplies** : IPA provided Motorola Hand Held Radios, Spare Batteries, Belt Clips, 6 Bank Multi Unit Quick Chargers, Programming Cables, Noise Cancelling Remote Speaker Microphones, and 2-wire Surveillance Kits.

**Supply Chain & Logistics** : IPA was responsible for the ordering, inspection, consolidation, packaging and shipping of the entire project. IPA negotiated with the manufacturer to obtain the most competitive pricing. We also inspected the goods at their point of origin to ensure they met IPA's quality control standards, prior to shipping. In analyzing our logistics approach, it was determined that the equipment should be export packed on ISPM15 compliant pallets for shipping to Port-au-Prince Haiti.
