Needs Assessment : This project has been in existence for quite some time, however the needs continuously change in terms of drilling conditions and locations. IPA actively performs analysis on equipment provided and uses this as input in subsequent deliveries. Whether it be recovery winches or water tanks, or cranes we strive to supply the most efficient package.

Equipment & Supplies : Mercedes Benz 4x4 and 6x4 Heavy Duty Trucks configured with Atlas Copco Compressors & Drill Rigs. Also units equipped with Hoisting Cranes & Winches, Recovery Winches, Generators, Cargo Flatbeds, Grundfos Pumps, Workshops, etc. In addition, consumables as drilling tools, spare parts, all-terrain tires and water test equipment.

Supply Chain & Logistics : Tailored supply chain with combination of consolidation of equipment in warehouses as well shipment of trucks to final destination to include inland African destinations. Reporting to client on weekly basis to provide status updates and 24/7 via web portal to download shipping documents.
