Objective : To provide expeditious, economical and seamless shipping for all VSAT (telecommunication) equipment worldwide. This process includes the inventory, consolidation, packaging evaluation, export-packing, documentation and delivery of the goods.

Needs Assessment : There is a constant need to provide the best shipping method for each country’s project. Multiple shipping options are requested in order to evaluate the best method that fits the field office’s budget, time frame requirements and other needs.

Equipment & Supplies : The client purchases the equipment directly from the manufacturer, who in turn delivers to IPA’s warehouse to be used as inventory or consolidated for shipment.

Supply Chain & Logistics : Goods are delivered to IPA’s warehouse where they are stored as inventory or are consolidated and evaluated for shipping. The goods are then export-packed according to their shipment method and transported to the appropriate loading facility for transport. Full documentation and shipment tracking is provided in order to facilitate a transparent shipping process.

Support & Aftersales : IPA provides additional support through supplementary documentation or shipment inspections (per specific country requirements).
